

Economic System



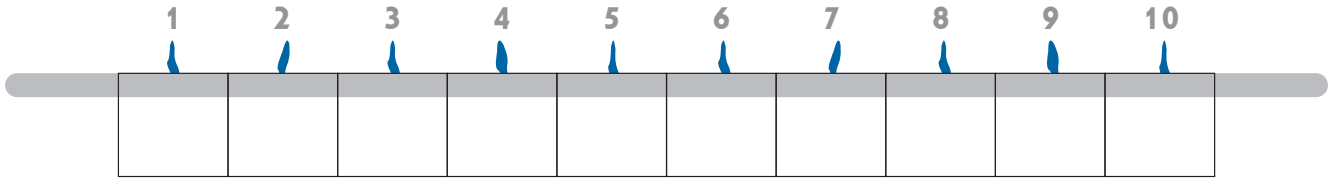
Capitalist system, unrestricted by workers' rights, or by laws limiting owners' or managers' authority.

National Culture



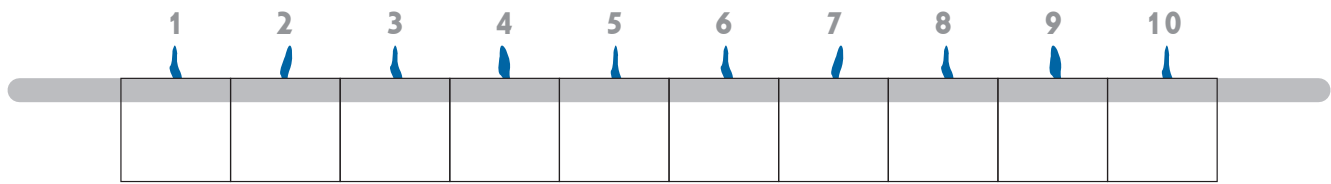
Home-grown Jewish culture with limited foreign influence.

Official Language



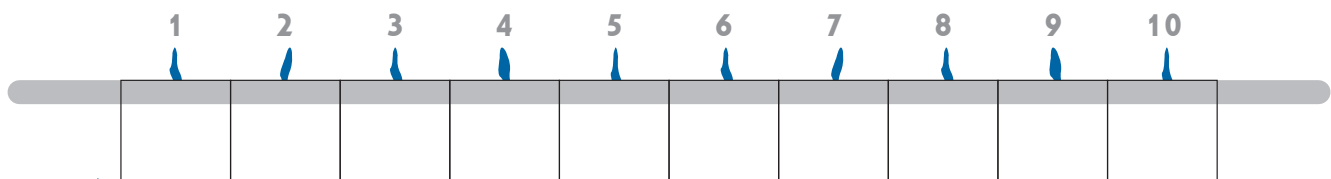
In a Jewish state, the official language must be Hebrew and all immigrants must learn it.

In a Jewish state, women should have a traditional role in the home.

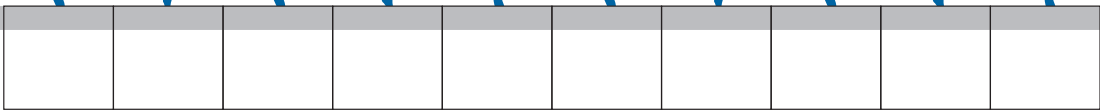
Opposing Position

Arabs have national aspirations and will not be content in a Jewish state. They should not be encouraged to remain through equality.

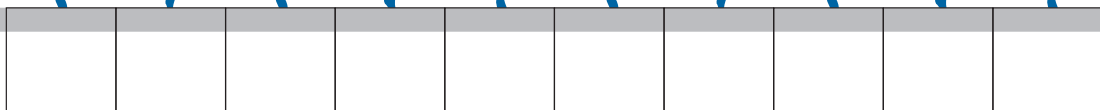
Opposing Position
